Professional Experience:

I have done my undergraduate medical [MBBS] and post graduate surgical training [MS] from R G KAR Medical College. As a part of my postgraduate thesis, I conducted a study on colon cancer: 'An epidemiological study of colorectal cancer in a tertiary teaching hospital in eastern part of India'. To further my desire to be a GI Surgical Oncologist, I underwent three-year fellowship training programme [PDF] at Tata medical Center (TMC), Kolkata. During this period, I had excellent exposure to the management of a wide spectrum of GI and Thoracic malignancies. Later in my role as Consultant, I was able to competently perform many of the procedures I learnt at TMC

After completing my training at Tata Medical Center, I joined as Associate Consultant in GI-HPB Surgical Oncology at **Medica Cancer Hospital, Siliguri**. Being the first GI Surgical Oncologist there, I was uniquely positioned to be able to develop, from the start, a new department. From August 2015 to August 2017, I performed a wide variety of operations for GI malignancies, including Cytoreductive Surgery [CRS] with HIPEC. Later I worked as Consultant in GI-HPB Surgical Oncology in **Narayana Super-specialty Hospital, Howrah**. Among my achievements there, I am proud to have successfully started a Peritoneal Surface Oncology programme at Narayana Super-specialty Hospital. Since August 2018, I have been working at **Tata Medical Center, Kolkata** as Senior consultant in the Department of GI-HPB Surgery (Upper GI and Peritoneal Surface Oncology services). I have been an observer to Seoul National University Hospital and Asan Medical Center, South Korea. I maintain my keen interest in minimally

invasive upper GI surgery (Laparoscopic and Robotic esophagus and gastric surgery), retroperitoneal sarcoma surgery and peritoneal surface malignancies (HIPEC and PIPAC).
